> June Door Offering

Our June door offering will support *The Apache Mission*. This was the first world mission of WELS. It was begun in 1893 and is located in eastern Arizona. The Fort Apache Reservation congregations are: East Fork, Canyon Day, Cibecue, McNary, and White River. There are 145 students/Grades K-8 at East Fork Lutheran School. (This area is served by one WELS missionary, two native pastors, and one evangelist.) The San Carlos Reservation congregations are San Carlos, Peridot, and Bylas, (being served by two WELS missionaries.) There are 130 students/K-8 at Peridot-Our Savior's Lutheran School. 17 teachers (four Apache) serve at the two schools. School enrollment continues to grow due to their higher academic standards, well rounded curriculum and affordable voucher system. The Apache Christian Training School located at East Fork is training 60 future leaders as evangelists, teachers, and pastors.
