Board of Spiritual Growth Notes

- Bible studies are now offered Monday afternoons, Thursday evenings, and Sunday mornings. A second Sunday bible study will be offered in the fall.

- The board approved plans for a gradual return to normal worship activities.

- Mulch was spread in all of the beds around the church & school buildings.
- Floor waxing is being done by Jack's Maintenance.
- Rooms are being re-aligned and furnished for additional offices and classrooms.

VBS & Summer Camps Recap

Several members have been surprised by lower-thannormal participation in our VBS, so we thought an explanation would be helpful. Due to COVID, we were seeking to spread out participation, and we decided to offer a Vacation Bible School for younger children (age 3-grade 2) and S.T.E.M. and Art Camps for older children (grades 3-6). Between the three events, 99 children attended. We suspect that a later start to our promotion (due to COVID uncertainty) and the busier summer for many families (with fewer restrictions than 2020) led to some decline in participation. We also are intentionally shifting our focus to make these events more outreach-focused, seeking to connect with more unchurched people. This meant less promotion among area WELS churches. This year, of the 99 who attended, 16 were unchurched. (In 2019, only 18 of the 173 who attended were unchurched.) The Evangelism Board will discuss the changes we made this year, as we make plans for reaching out in 2022 and beyond!
